15 December 2011

These are notes of the LEAP meeting on Thursday 15th December at Joanna's house.

At the meeting were: Keith Vivers (Treasurer), Joanna Cadman (Chairman), Zoe Horton, Claire McGill and Eddie Breeveld (Secretary).

Matters Arising

- Footpath and churchyard clearance, 12 November 2011.
 - This was very successful, thanks to all who helped organise, clear up, and provide cakes and drinks.
 - It was a lovely day, we were lucky with the weather. We had a nice note from the PC (via Chris Lyth) thanking us for our efforts with the footpaths.
 - We will research next year, maybe the footpaths on the Parish boundary at Baynard's, although see the item below on pond clearing.
- Pond Clearance.
 - It was thought that that there are few if any paths left with both a need for clearance and willing (i.e. identifiable) landowners. Perhaps instead we could clear out the 'village' pond by the car park.
 - Keith will contact Sarah Henderson about what is best to do, as well as when and how.
 - \circ This is likely to be an autumn job, and further details can wait until a future meeting.
 - We would advertise this to the village in a box in the Parish News.
- Ewhurst Walks
 - Keith and Debbie Vivers had given a few of us a copy of the first pair of walks one short and one long.
 - Alice and Millie Breeveld had walked the shorter and confirmed it was just over an hour long, ideal for a 'Village walk'. The longer one was estimated at 3 hours, and it was suggested that it was walked in the other direction (hard but short up hill to start, instead of hard downhill to finish).
 - The Village walk would be to celebrate the Diamond Jubilee and take place on the Tuesday Bank Holiday (5th June) 2:30pm to 3:30pm from the Village car park, with everybody welcome.

 - The Village walk would be a launch for the series of walks by Debbie and Keith and 'published' by LEAP.
 - Keith will make up the words for the shorter walk, and reverse the instructions for the longer.
 - The walks would be available for sale on laminated paper at 50p for small and £1 for big.
