Meeting Notes

21st February 2013

- Clear Out Day – 7th July 2013
 - Joanna to ask Parish Council for grant towards cost of using EYSC building for Clear Out Day – Action: Joanna
 - Eddie should have a banner ready for Clear Out Day (£99 quoted) and come up with new design for logo – Action: Eddie
 - Leaflets to be printed and distributed about around end of June.
 - Lesley Wood had suggested having a plant swap at this year's Clear Out Day and will speak to Waverley Council.
 - Left over plants could be put outside the EYSC
 - Member of Horticultural Society to identify plants
- Ewhurst Walks
 - It is planned to do the Long Walk (3 hours approx) on either 13th or 20th April 2013, depending on whether Keith can manage these dates. Otherwise someone to go through walk with him.
 - Eddie to provide maps – Action: Eddie
 - Posters to be produced and distributed – Action: Joanna/Claire
 - 1.30 start from Village Car Park
 - Tea afterwards. Joanna to find out cost of Wilson Room – Action: Joanna
- Footpath Clearance
 - County Council has asked for volunteers for footpath clearance, but LEAP not mentioned.
 - Eddie and Jenny attended the Village Society Meeting on Monday 25th February, where Chris Lyth said that he was asking for volunteers to clear footpaths and that LEAP would organise this under the parish council's 'umbrella' to cover insurance. Joanna to discuss with him and report back – Action: Joanna

- Pond Clearance (instead of footpath above)
 - Joanna has not heard any more from Waverley re. pond – too late for this year but possibly next winter.
- Big Day Out
 - It was decided to have a LEAP stall every second year when the Ewhurst Carnival is held on the Recreation Ground.
 - There will not, therefore, be a LEAP stall at this year's Big Day Out, which is being held at the Hurtwood Polo Club, on the 13th July 2013.
- LEAP Quiz Night
 - Jenny has provisionally booked Monday 2nd September 2013 for a fund raising Quiz Night at the Bull's Head.
 - Bull's Head will provide a raffle (extra items welcome) and charge £2 a head - proceeds are split 50/50.
 - Jenny to arrange a date for Richard to talk to Liz O'Brian – Action: Jenny/Richard
- Litter Pick
 - Decision to be made as to what needs doing. Eddie said it would be better to concentrate on the perimeter rather than the centre of the village, though Recreation Ground always needs clearing.
 - Could combine Litter Pick with Footpath Clearance.
 - Joanna to speak to Chris Lyth and Waverley Council – Action: Joanna
- Parish Council Meeting - 24th April 2013 at 7.30pm.
 - Richard to do short talk on LEAP – Action: Richard.
