- Ancillary Items:
 - o Jenny Lewis has sadly had to resign from LEAP owing to bad health.
 - Gazebo still needs repairing Action: Eddie/Richard
- Village Hall Project
 - o Liz Townsend elected and £70,000 not ringfenced for ruralisation of Ewhurst.
 - £1,700 given towards Village Hall enhancement but extra funding available if necessary.
 - o Ewhurst Players may produce some funding.
 - o Joanna has spoken to Andrew Wright, who will provide quotation as he will source and take charge of the project.
 - LEAP to organise the construction of large planters in front of the Village Hall.
 - Working party to be organised for Saturday, 10th July am/pm sessions **Action: Eddie**
 - Joanna to arrange for Andrew to be with her by 9am to move sleepers ready for work to begin at 10am – Action: Joanna
 - ✓ Rubble needed for planter drainage.
 - ✓ Bins to be moved across the road to Village Car Park.
 - ✓ These must be placed at least one metre away from roadside.
 - ✓ Planters to be 3ft in height and placed at least 1 metre from kerb.
 - ✓ 4 planters overall 2 by windows (2x3ft), 1 by bins and another (both 2x4ft) 1 metre from kerb.
- Solar Streets
 - o Problem in that Cranleigh might go ahead this summer with Solar Together.
 - o Ewhurst cannot proceed with Solar Streets unless Cranleigh does as well.
 - Parish Council need to be on board.
 - o Parish Council to declare a Climate Change Emergency.
 - o Could consider again in 2022.
 - o If huge amount of enthusiasm from Cranleigh (enough for both schemes) then will think again.

- Footpaths
 - Footpath from Coneyhurst to Wykehurst Lane to be done possibly Sep 21.
 - Pound Farm footpath and footpaths off Old House Drive and North Breach Manor all need to be cut back.
- Carnival 7th August 2021
 - o It was agreed that Jackie's wildlife knitted toys would be sold on the LEAP stall together with wildlife photos profits to go towards LEAP **Action: Richard**
 - Joanna to print out labels for wildflower seeds and Eddie/Alice to put into envelopes –
 Action: Eddie/Joanna
